- A combination of quick wins and long-term actions.
- Free E-learning from external sources to help build your understanding of the topics.
- Checklists that can be used to capture any actions that you take as part of your net zero journey. This can be used as part of a plan and to validate and keep track of what your business implements to limit the potential for any greenwashing.
- Questionnaires to complete for each emissions-related aspect of your business. This will help you to understand what you can do within your organisation, help with employee engagement and highlight what you can do and think about on your net zero journey.
- This toolkit can be shared throughout your organisation. Both to inform your staff, but also make them aware that your organisation has joined the Pledge and that you are committed.

The toolkit follows an assess > plan > implement > check > promote process.

The process allows businesses to strategically work towards net zero and maximize the benefits in a cost-effective and credible way.
